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MOBILE FOOD SERVICE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

1. All facilities licensed as a mobile food service must have an approved, **licensed commissary**.
2. There will be no food service operations (water supply, food preparation, food storage, utensil, or unit cleaning) in conjunction with a private residence or other living quarters.
3. The mobile unit must meet all requirements of 410 IAC 7-24 particular to the product being served including plan review. These requirements include but are not restricted to:
 - Suitable hand washing facilities.
 - Cleanable walls, floors and ceilings.
 - Adequate mechanical refrigeration, if required.
 - Adequate mechanical hot holding if required.
 - Adequate ventilation where high heat or grease are produced.
 - Adequate fly, insect and rodent control.
 - All food products must be from an approved source and prepared in an approved licensed facility.

Commissaries: Must be a licensed food service facility, and inspected by a state or local health department.

Identification: Mobile Food Facility operators shall provide the Vanderburgh County Health Dept. a list of their licensed vehicle(s). Include; make, model, and color of the vehicle(s), vehicle license plate number(s). Operators name, address and telephone # shall be conspicuously displayed on the mobile unit.
