



## **VOLUNTEERS NEEDED**

**May 19, 2013**  
**1 to 4PM**

Your help is needed! Evansville Streets Alive! is a car-free festival of physical activity and healthy foods on 1.2 miles of Fulton Ave. from Maryland St. to Diamond Ave., connecting to 1.4 miles of the Greenway. Volunteers are the heart, soul, and backbone of Evansville Streets Alive! You have three volunteer shifts to choose from and you'll still have plenty of time to explore the route and enjoy the festivities.

**Intersection Volunteer (18 years & older)** – One of the most important volunteer opportunities is helping out at the intersections. There are many intersections along the Fulton Ave. route that need to be staffed by volunteers during the event. Barricades weigh about 15 pounds and will need to be set up before the event, monitored during the event, and broken down after the event. Volunteers will also help guide participants as they travel along the route and help residents living along the route enter and exit their homes. Two volunteers are needed at each barricade so find a friend, family member, or co-worker and buddy-up!

- **Children's Area** – Assist with children's activities - keeping inventory on items such as hula hoops, jump ropes, etc., keeping children playing safely, encouraging lots of movement; and if a child is lost, taking them to the First-Aid Tent.
- **Food and Eat Way** – Help vendors set-up in the beginning of the day and help them get out at the end of the day. If vendors have any needs, assist to the best of your ability.
- **Block Captains** – Greet vendors in your block, issue them information packets and trash bins. Help vendors with set-up at the beginning of the day and help them get out at the end of the day. If vendors have any needs, assist to the best of your ability. Help keep your block safe and leave it clean.
- **Activity Alley** – Facilitate flow of activity, keeping the neighborhood clean and encouraging safety. All activities are open to everyone.
- **Lane Captains** – Fulton Avenue will be used for running, walking, biking, and skating lanes. Please monitor route directions, keeping lanes safe and clear of danger.
- **Info Stations** – Tell participants about the location of activities, bike parking, music, bathrooms, food vendors, route information, etc. All information and a large event map will be available for reference. If there is a lost child or parent, take them to the First-Aid Tent.
- **Bus Stop Guard** – Help attendees with shuttle schedule. The shuttle will drop off attendees every 30 minutes. Stay in contact with the driver to keep better timing.
- **Evaluation Team** – Walk around the event, asking participants to fill out a simple survey. The survey will help Evansville Streets Alive! understand who attends open street events, where they come from, and what they would like to see at future events. Turn in completed surveys to the information booth at the end of your shift.
