

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE COMMON COUNCIL  
 OF THE CITY OF EVANSVILLE AUTHORIZING TRANSFERS  
 OF APPROPRIATIONS, ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS  
 AND REPEAL AND RE-APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS  
 FOR VARIOUS CITY FUNDS**

**SECTION I. TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATIONS**

THAT FOR THE EXPENSES OF VARIOUS CITY DEPARTMENTS, THE FOLLOWING APPROPRIATIONS ARE HEREBY TRANSFERRED AND ORDERED SET APART OUT OF THE FUNDS HEREIN NAMED AND FOR THE PURPOSE SPECIFIED, SUBJECT TO THE LAWS GOVERNING THE SAME:

Request to fund blight elimination program. This funding will allow the City to initiate a large scale acquisition and demolition effort of blighted properties. The Evansville Brownfield Corporation (EBC) would begin as soon as funding is approved and the Vanderburgh County Commissioners transfer ownership of the unsold tax sale properties that they now have in reserve. The City anticipates being able to demolish roughly 200 blighted structures this year, and also fund the operation of the land bank, including two contract employees to complete the tasks of day-to-day operations for the Brownfield Corporation/Land Bank of Evansville. The City should be able to clear and bank blighted properties to secure the land for new housing development to restore the property tax base in the urban core of Evansville. EBC will begin issuing Request for Qualifications for demolition as soon as the property transfers are complete and the program is in place to manage the process. (Part 1 of 2)

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
**SECTION IV. EFFECTIVE DATE**


